Riders who qualify must submit their details at www.bluechipchamps.co.uk to register their qualification.

Class 4 - Blue Chip Dynamic Grades B & C Championship Qualifier

Rule 304. Table A7. Speed 350mpm. Start Heights 1.30m / 1.25m.

For registered horses in Grades B&C to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior members.

This is a handicap class, the Grade B start height is 1.30m and the Grade C start height is 1.25m.

The first 8 horses qualify for the final, held at the Blue Chip Winter Championships. Qualification does not pass down the line. Qualifiers must jump a clear in the first round. There will be dual qualification of double clears for the National B&C Handicap Championship.

Numbers to qualify: Two double clears to qualify for the final. Also any two double clears from any International Trial or Area Trial or classes 1.40m or above in the qualifying period will qualify for the Final. Double clear qualifications will not be obtained from competitions comprised of a single round.

Entry qualifications: To be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships and Olympic Games are not eligible).

For both:

a) registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 Points

b) registered horses born on or after 1st January 2012, irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for qualification if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Winter Novice Championship final.

Horses with 21 or more British Eventing points are not eligible to compete in this Class

Qualifies for: The SEIB Winter Novice Championship at the Royal International Horse Show. No competitor may ride more than two horses in the Final. Horses that are disregarded under Rule 506.6 that otherwise would have qualified may be substituted in the Final for horses already qualified by the same rider, subject to Rule 79.4.

Numbers to qualify: Two disregarding those already qualified and horses ridden by riders who have already qualified two horses for the Championship.

Prizes: 1st: £150.00, 2nd: £100.00, 3rd: £75.00, 4th: £60.00, 5th: £35.00, 6th: £30.00, Total: £450.00. **Entry Fee = £30.00**

Class 8 - Equitop Myoplast Senior Foxhunter First Round/Grade C

Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.20m.

Foxhunter Section:

First place rosette kindly sponsored by Equitop Myoplast

See BS Handbook rule 310 for entry eligibility and qualification criteria.

Grade C section: For registered horses in Grade C ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

One set of prizes awarded and horses may only enter one section.

Prizes: 1st: £400.00, 2nd: £300.00, 3rd: £200.00, 4th: £100.00, 5th: £100.00, 6th: £52.00, 7th: £48.00 **Entry Fee = £48.00**

Class 10 - Winter Grades B&C Qualifier

Rule 505. Table A7. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.35m.

For registered horses in Grades B & C to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Qualifies for: Winter Grades B&C Championship at the Royal International Horse Show. No competitor may ride more than two horses in the Final. 24 riders directly qualify for the main arena. Horses that are disregarded under Rule 505.6 that otherwise would have qualified may be substituted in the Final for horses already qualified by the same rider, subject to Rule 79.4.

Numbers to qualify: Two, disregarding those already qualified, and horses ridden by riders who have already qualified two horses.

Prizes: 1st: £200.00, 2nd: £150.00, 3rd: £100.00, 4th: £70.00, 5th: £44.00, 6th: £36.00

Entry Fee = £36.00

Numbers to qualify: The first 6 horse/rider combinations, disregarding the ones already qualified. In instances where riders qualify multiple rides Rules 290.17 and 77.6 apply.

Prizes: 1st: £150.00, 2nd: £100.00, 3rd: £75.00, 4th: £60.00, 5th: £35.00, 6th: £30.00, Total: £450.00. **Entry Fee = £30.00**

Class 13 - Winter 7 Year Old Qualifier

Table A10. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.20m.

For registered horses born on or after 1 January 2011, to be ridden by Adult Associate or Junior Members.

Qualifies for: Winter 7 Year Old Final at the Spring Championship Show.

Numbers to qualify: The first 6 horse/rider combinations, disregarding the ones already qualified. In instances where riders qualify multiple rides Rules 290.17 and 77.6 apply.

Prizes: 1st: £175.00, 2nd: £125.00, 3rd: £90.00, 4th: £50.00, 5th: £45.00, 6th: £40.00, Total: £525.00. **Entry Fee = £32.40**

Class 14 - Winter Grade C Qualifier

Rule 507. Table A7. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.30m.

For registered horses in Grade C to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Qualifies for: Winter Grade C Final at the Spring Championship Show.

Qualifying period: There will be 12 qualifying competitions. Qualifiers to be held at the Winter Premier Shows, Development Classic Shows, plus two additional venues.

Numbers to qualify: Four to qualify, disregarding those already qualified, and horses ridden by riders who have already qualified two horses. Riders may only ride two horses in the Final.

Horses which are disregarded which otherwise would have qualified may be substituted in the Final for horses already qualified by the same rider, subject to Rule 79.4.

Prizes: 1st: £200.00, 2nd: £150.00, 3rd: £100.00, 4th: £70.00, 5th: £44.00, 6th: £36.00

Entry Fee = £36.00

Class 15 - Winter National 1.35m Open

Rule 302. Table A10. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.35m.

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to registered horses of any grade, to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Qualifying period: There will be 10 qualifying competitions. Qualifiers to be held at the Winter Premier Shows and at the Development Classic Shows.

Qualifies for: Winter National 1.35m Open Championship at the British Showjumping Winter Championships

Numbers to qualify: Top 3 horse/rider combinations to qualify, disregarding those already qualified. Riders may only compete on one horse in the Final, qualification in accordance with Rule 290.17.

Prizes: 1st: £500.00, 2nd: £300.00, 3rd: £250.00, 4th: £200.00, 5th: £120.00, 6th: £70.00, 7th: £60.00 **Entry Fee = £60.00**
