## Class 2. 1'6'' (45cm) ELF'S ENDEAVOUR

Two rounds, first round 1'6'' (c.45cm), second round against the clock, no doubles or combinations. Lead rein or assistance permitted; rider any age, horse or pony **This class is for novice/nervous riders/mounts only.** 

## Class 3. 2' (60cm) RUDOLPH'S RAMPAGE

Two rounds, first round max 2' (60 cm), second round against the clock, no doubles or combinations; rider any age, horse or pony. assistance permitted. This class is for novice/nervous riders/mounts only.

# Class 4. 2'3" (70cm) CHRISTMAS CRACKERS

Two rounds, first round max 2'3''(70 cm), second round against the clock, no doubles or combinations; rider any age, horse or pony. Special Prize for the best decorated combination.

### Class 5. 2'6" (75-80cm) BRILLIANT BAUBLES

Two rounds, first round max 2'6'' (75-80cm), second round against the clock; rider any age, horse or pony. Overall Winner to also receive 2no. tickets for the EQUESTRIAN.COM Liverpool International Horse Show!!\*

### **Class 6. PAIR UP FOR PRESENTS**

Pairs Relay: 80cm - 90 cm;

If there is a high volume of entries classes scheduled to be two rounds may run two- or single-phase at the organisers' discretion. BSJA rules apply, <u>except</u>: juniors/seniors, horses/ponies compete together, lead rein (classes 1&2) or one person giving assistance (classes 1,2,3) permitted (strictly no altering of jumps, chasing, nor use of whip), 3rd refusal/disobedience or 1st dismount = elimination; re-mounting not permitted; refusal or knockdown=4 faults. note: Classes 1-3 are for novice or nervous riders or novice mounts only. Combinations competing in class 1 may not compete in classes 4 -8. Combinations in class 2 may not compete in classes 5-8. Combinations in class 3 may not compete in classes 6-8.
