For registered horses that have qualified to compete by jumping double clear rounds in at least four Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers First Round competitions in accordance with Rule 312.6. There will be 10 Second Round competitions. Qualified horses are eligible to be entered and to compete in any four of the 10 Second Round competitions.

Qualifies for: Horse of the Year Show & the British Showjumping National Championships.

Numbers to qualify: The first two horses, disregarding those already qualified, will qualify for the Horse of the Year Show. The first five, disregarding those already qualified, and all those jumping treble clear, will qualify for the British Showjumping National Championships.

#### **British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling**

The total maximum weight of equipment allowed to be added to a horse's leg; front or hind (single or multiple boots, fetlock rings etc), is 500g.

All hind leg protections must have a maximum interior length of 16cm and a minimum exterior width of 5cm.

The inside protection must be smooth and the fixations must be made of non-elastic Velcro type fasteners with no hooks or straps permitted.

The rounded rigid part of the protection must be placed around the inside of the fetlock. No additional elements may be used in conjunction with the protection.

#### Failure to comply will incur disqualification.

Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify.

Four Double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st June-31st May inclusive.

For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

- a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify in accordance with Rule 314.6.
- b) For all horses that are five years or under at the year that the final is going to be held, irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final in accordance with Rule 314.6 Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship Second Round.

Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four First Round competitions held in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in and attend four Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

#### **British Showjumping Boots / Leg Protection Ruling**

The total maximum weight of equipment allowed to be added to a horse's leg; front or hind (single or multiple boots, fetlock rings etc), is 500g.

All hind leg protections must have a maximum interior length of 16cm and a minimum exterior width of 5cm.

The inside protection must be smooth and the fixations must be made of non-elastic Velcro type fasteners with no hooks or straps permitted.
