Class 1 - Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers - First Round/1.10m Open

Rule 312. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

Newcomers Section: First place rosette kindly sponsored by Connolly's RED Mills. Rule 312.6

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6

(b) For all registered horses that are six years or under at the year that the final is going to be held, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior Newcomers Final - in accordance with rule 312.6.

Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Second Rounds. Qualifying period 1st June - 31st May inclusive.

1:10 Open Section: For registered horses ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with prize money awarded per section. Horses may only compete in one section

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £22.00, 5th: £18.00, Total: £150.00. Entry Fee = £18.00

Class 2 - Equitop Myoplast Senior Foxhunter First Round/Grade C

Rule 310. Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.20m.

Foxhunter Section: First place rosette kindly sponsored by Equitop Myoplast. Rule 310.6

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6

(b) For all registered horses that are seven years or under at the year that the final is going to be held, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify.

Four Double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st June-31st May inclusive.

Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2017 are not eligible for qualification to the 2018 Championship.

Grade C section: For registered horses in Grade C ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Only one set of awards for this class regardless of entry level.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £35.00, 3rd: £25.00, 4th: £22.00, 5th: £18.00, Total: £150.00. Entry Fee = £18.00

Class 3 - Senior 1.25m Open

Single Phase. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.25m.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Prizes: 1st: £70.00, 2nd: £50.00, 3rd: £35.00, 4th: £25.00, 5th: £25.00, 6th: £20.00, Total: £225.00. Entry Fee = £20.00

Class 4 - KBIS Insurance Senior British Novice - First Round/90cm Open

Rule 316. Two Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

British Novice Section: First place rosette kindly sponsored by KBIS Insurance. Rule 316

For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 125 points ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Qualifies for: KBIS Insurance British Novice Championship - Second Round. Qualifying period yearly 1st May - 30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four KBIS Insurance British Novice First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in and attend four KBIS Insurance British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular KBIS Insurance British Novice competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

90cm Open Section: For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Prizes will be awarded per section and horses may only compete in one section.

Class 5 - Nupafeed Supplements Senior Discovery First Round/1m Open

Rule 314. Two Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

Discovery Section: Rule 314

a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

b) For all horses that are five years or under at the year that the final is going to be held, irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

 $Qualifies \ for: \ Nupa feed \ Supplements \ Discovery \ Championship \ Second \ Round. \ Qualifying \ period: \ 1st \ May-30th \ April \ inclusive.$

Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four First Round competitions held in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in and attend four Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

1.00m Open Section: For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Prizes will be awarded per section and horses may only compete in one section.
