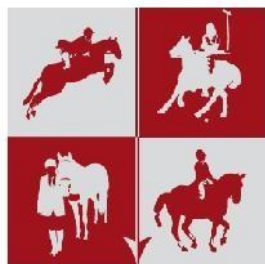

Rule 406 & 416. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m. **PLEASE STATE SECTION ENTERED CLEARLY!!**

Newcomer Section: First place rosette kindly sponsored by Blue Chip

for registered Ponies in Grade JC & JD that have not won a total of 500 points to be ridden by Junior Members. Qualifies for: Blue Chip Pony Newcomers Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.
Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Blue Chip Pony Newcomers First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony Newcomers Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). The winner of a particular Blue Chip Pony Newcomers First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. Ponies in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification.

Open Section is open to all.

Restricted Rider: Registered ponies competing in either the Open or the Newcomers Section, ridden by Junior Members who have not won a total of 500 Points are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship.

Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April. Qualification is Pony/Rider Combination. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.00m Final.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and awards made per section. Ponies may compete in one section only.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £30.00, 3rd: £27.00, 4th: £23.00, 5th: £20.00, Total: £150.00.

Entry Fee = £19.20

Class 2 - Blue Chip Pro Sparkle JC/JA Championship Qualifier

Rule 284. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Start Heights 1.15m / 1.20m. **PLEASE STATE SECTION ENTERED CLEARLY!!**

For registered ponies in grades JC & JA, **excluding those ponies qualified for The Pony Show Jumper of the Year at HOYS which can use this class as a warm up but cannot qualify for the Blue Chip Winter Championships 2018****

To be ridden by Junior Members.

The first 8 ponies qualify for the final, held at the Blue Chip Winter Championships. Qualified JC ponies which upgrade will compete in the JC section of the final. However, if they qualify again as a JA, they will compete in the JA section of the final. Qualification does not pass down the line. Qualifiers must jump clear in the first round.

Riders who qualify must submit their details at www.bluechipchamps.co.uk to register their qualification.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £30.00, 3rd: £27.00, 4th: £23.00, 5th: £20.00, Total: £150.00.

Class 3 - Charles Britton Equestrian Construction Winter JA Classic Championship Qualifier

Rule 511. Table A8. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.30m.

First-third place rosettes and £50 of prize fund kindly sponsored by Charles Britton Equestrian Construction

For registered ponies in Grade JA to be ridden by Pony or Junior Members. Ponies in Grade JC at closing date of entries are not eligible to be entered.

Qualifies for: Charles Britton Equestrian Construction Winter Grade JA Championship Final. Qualifiers to be held at the Winter 148cm Pony Premier Shows.

Numbers to qualify: First three to qualify. Qualifiers must jump clear in first round, disregarding those already qualified and ponies ridden by riders who have already qualified two ponies. Ponies will qualify to compete in the Final in which they must be ridden by the rider who rode them when qualifying. No competitor may ride more than two ponies in the Final. Ponies which are disregarded which otherwise would have qualified may be substituted in the Final for ponies already qualified by the same rider, subject to Rule 79.4.

Prizes: 1st: £150.00, 2nd: £100.00, 3rd: £75.00, 4th: £53.00, 5th: £36.00, 6th: £36.00, Total: £450.00. **Entry Fee = £36.00**

Class 4 - Winter JC Qualifier

Rule 517. Table A8. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.15m.

For registered Grade JC ponies at 1st January to be ridden by Junior Members. Qualified ponies may compete in all or any of the 10 competitions.

Qualifies for: Winter Grade JC Championship Final at the Royal International Horse Show. No competitor may ride more than two ponies in the Final. Qualifying period: Qualifiers to be held at the Winter 148cms Pony Premier Shows.

Numbers to qualify: *Three Pony/Rider combinations on day one and two Pony/Rider combinations on day two of the schedule, disregarding those already qualified and ponies ridden by riders who have already qualified two ponies. *Subject to change*.

Ponies which are disregarded under Rule 517.6, which otherwise would have qualified may be substituted in the Final for ponies already qualified by the same rider, subject to Rule 79.4.

Prizes: 1st: £100.00, 2nd: £55.00, 3rd: £50.00, 4th: £35.00, 5th: £33.00, 6th: £27.00, Total: £300.00. **Entry Fee = £26.40**

Class 5 - Pony Foxhunter/1.10m Open (both to Inc. The Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Qualifier)

Rule 404 & 417. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m. **PLEASE STATE SECTION ENTERED CLEARLY**

Pony Foxhunter Section: for ponies in Grades JD and JC that have not won a total of 700 Points to be ridden by Junior Members.

Qualifies for: Pony Foxhunter Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four First Round competitions held in the qualifying period will qualify to compete in the Second Round irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). The winner of a particular competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. Ponies in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification.

Open Section: open to all.

Restricted Rider: Registered ponies competing in either the Open or the Foxhunter Section, ridden by Junior members who have not won more than a total of 350 Points in the previous calendar year are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship.

Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.10m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualification is pony/rider combination. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.10m Final.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £30.00, 3rd: £27.00, 4th: £23.00, 5th: £20.00, Total: £150.00.

Entry Fee = £19.20

Class 6 - British Showjumping 148cm Special

Rule 398. Table A10. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.15m.

For registered ponies in Grades: JA, JC & JD to be ridden by junior members.

Prizes: 1st: £75.00, 2nd: £43.00, 3rd: £38.00, 4th: £25.00, 5th: £22.00, 6th: £22.00, Total: £225.00.

Entry Fee = £22.00

Newcomer Section: First place rosette kindly sponsored by Blue Chip

for registered Ponies in Grade JC & JD that have not won a total of 500 points to be ridden by Junior Members. Qualifies for: Blue Chip Pony Newcomers Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.
Numbers to qualify: Those ponies that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off in at least four Blue Chip Pony Newcomers First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Pony Newcomers Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). The winner of a particular Blue Chip Pony Newcomers First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition. Ponies in the class must go into the jump-off and go clear to gain their double clear round qualification.

Open Section is open to all.

Restricted Rider: Registered ponies competing in either the Open or the Newcomers Section, ridden by Junior Members who have not won a total of 500 Points are eligible for double clear qualification for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship.

Qualifies for: Four double clears will qualify for the Pony Restricted Rider 1.00m Championship to be held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April. Qualification is Pony/Rider Combination. Riders who have accrued points on the Pony Gold League are not eligible to compete in the Restricted Rider 1.00m Final.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and awards made per section. Ponies may compete in one section only.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £30.00, 3rd: £27.00, 4th: £23.00, 5th: £20.00, Total: £150.00.

Class 8 - Grades JA and JC Open Handicap

Rule 284. Table A4. Speed 325mpm. Start Heights 1.20m / 1.10m.

For registered ponies in Grades JC & JA to be ridden by Junior Members.

Ponies will be permitted to jump in the larger section of the handicap competition without penalty.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £30.00, 3rd: £27.00, 4th: £23.00, 5th: £20.00, Total: £150.00.

Entry Fee = £19.20

Class 9 - Winter JC Qualifier

Rule 517. Table A8. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.15m.

Qualified ponies may compete in all or any of the 10 competitions.

Qualifies for: Winter Grade JC Championship Final at the Royal International Horse Show. No competitor may ride more than two ponies in the Final. Qualifying period: Qualifiers to be held at the Winter 148cms Pony Premier Shows.

Numbers to qualify: *Three Pony/Rider combinations on day one and two Pony/Rider combinations on day two of the schedule, disregarding those already qualified and ponies ridden by riders who have already qualified two ponies. *Subject to change*.

Ponies which are disregarded under Rule 517.6, which otherwise would have qualified may be substituted in the Final for ponies already qualified by the same rider, subject to Rule 79.4.

Prizes: 1st: £100.00, 2nd: £55.00, 3rd: £50.00, 4th: £35.00, 5th: £33.00, 6th: £27.00, Total: £300.00. **Entry Fee = £26.40**

Class 10 - Charles Britton Equestrian Construction Winter JA Classic Championship Qualifier

Rule 511. Table A8. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.30m. First-third place rosettes and £50 of prize fund kindly sponsored by Charles Britton Equestrian Construction

For registered ponies in Grade JA to be ridden by Pony or Junior Members. Ponies in Grade JC at closing date of entries are not eligible to be entered.

Qualifies for: Charles Britton Equestrian Construction Winter Grade JA Championship Final. Qualifiers to be held at the Winter 148cm Pony Premier Shows.

Numbers to qualify: First three to qualify. Qualifiers must jump clear in first round, disregarding those already qualified and ponies ridden by riders who have already qualified two ponies. Ponies will qualify to compete in the Final in which they must be ridden by the rider who rode them when qualifying. No competitor may ride more than two ponies in the Final. Ponies which are disregarded which otherwise would have qualified may be substituted in the Final for ponies already qualified by the same rider, subject to Rule 79.4.

Prizes: 1st: £150.00, 2nd: £100.00, 3rd: £75.00, 4th: £53.00, 5th: £36.00, 6th: £36.00, Total: £450.00. **Entry Fee = £36.00**

Class 11 - 148cm Restricted Open

Rule 399. Table A10. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.20m.

For registered ponies not exceeding 148cms. Open to all but for qualification purposes those riders who have ever been on a Pony European Championship team, Pony Nation Cups team or Pony/Rider combinations in the top 10 of the Gold league as of 31st March 2018 are not eligible to qualify for the Final.

Qualifies for: Final at the Welsh Home Pony Show. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April.

Numbers to qualify: Those combinations who jump double clear (clear in the first round and the first jump-off) (ONE DOUBLE CLEAR) in the qualifying period.

Prizes: 1st: £75.00, 2nd: £43.00, 3rd: £38.00, 4th: £25.00, 5th: £22.00, 6th: £22.00, Total: £225.00. **Entry Fee = £21.60**

Class 12 - HorseQuest UK Coral Championship Qualifier

Rule 404. Table A7. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

For registered ponies in grade JD & JC which have not won a total of 700 points, to be ridden by Junior Members.

The first 8 ponies qualify for the final, held at the Blue Chip Winter Championships. Qualification does not pass down the line. Qualifiers must jump clear in the first round. There will be dual qualification of double clears for the Pony Foxhunter first round.

Riders who qualify must submit their details at www.bluechipchamps.co.uk to register their qualification.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £30.00, 3rd: £27.00, 4th: £23.00, 5th: £20.00, Total: £150.00.
