Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team, (4* or 5* Nations Cup in the last 10 Years, World, European Championships and Olympic Games) are not eligible.

Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last five years are not eligible (Excluding Veteran and Para Teams).

Four double clears to qualify for the 85 cm National Amateur Second Rounds.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year.
