Winter weather and dark nights - struggling to get your horses and ponies exercised? Getting ready for BS or the eventing season..... or just want some fun with your horse?

Come and join us for clear round show jumping over a course of <u>BSJA show jumps.</u>

The perfect opportunity to gain ring experience, get horses worked or help with preparations for weekend competitions! Great for youngsters – show atmosphere without show pressure. All jumps optional. The height of fences for each height band will be up to the max. height stated below

Day Session

c.10am-11pm Height of fences 65-75cm

c.11am-1pm Height of fences 80-90cm

c.1pm-3pm Height of fences 95cm-1.05m

c.3pm-4pm Height of fences 1.05-1.15m

(If there is demand and sufficient time available, a limited number of rounds will be possible at higher height at 4pm)

<u>Evening Session</u> c.5pm-6pm Height of fences 55-65cm c.6pm-7pm Height of fences 70-80cm c.7pm-8pm Height of fences 80-90cm

(If there is demand and sufficient time available, a limited number of rounds will be possible at a higher height at 8pm)

<u>Please note that times stated are approximate and may alter slightly if demand at a particular level is high.</u> <u>In order to help us keep on schedule please ensure you arrive at least 20 minutes before the published close</u> <u>of the relevant height. We reserve the right to refuse entries for any level after this time.</u>

Cost : £7 per round jumped, plus £2 first aid contribution per rider per day; tickets must be purchased in advance at cafe and handed over at ring entry.

Show attire unnecessary but note properly fitting hat and boots MUST be worn. No altering of fences allowed.

Hot and cold food available in heated café & bar throughout the day.

For these measures to be effective everyone attending must also take all reasonable care to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must at all times obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards. Collecting ring for warm up of those who have made payment to jump only prior to jumping their round. Max. one helper permitted in ring during round – no chasing or use of lunge whips. Strictly no entry to ring without prepaid entry ticket. **Obstacles must be jumped in the order and direction numbered and once only**, though fences may be omitted. The ring supervisor may permit repeated attempts on refusal at an obstacle, but you must move on and omit the obstacle at the ring supervisor's direction and may only return to attempt the missed obstacle only with their express permission.
